

INSTALL GUIDE ADDENDUM

New Install Options

The CD provided in this package now offers two install options:

- **Amicus Attorney 2008 Premium Edition with Service Pack 1.** This option WILL NOT UPDATE existing Version 2008 Premium installations. (Existing installations must update to SP1 via the Update Service website, accessed by going to the Windows Start menu and choosing Amicus > Amicus Attorney 2008 PE Tools > Check For Updates.)
- **Amicus Mobile Server.** Amicus Mobile is an optional add-on product to Amicus Attorney, with separate licensing requirements.

Separate install guides are included for each option.

If upgrading from Amicus Attorney 7 hosted under MSDE or SQL Server 2000

It is not recommended, and not necessary, to first update your Version 7 instance of SQL to SQL Server 2005. Save steps and time by following the Amicus Server Upgrade procedure detailed in the *Install Guide*. Upon completing Steps A and B of that procedure, your Version 7 database will have been deleted from the existing SQL instance. Continue to Step C and install a new named instance ("AMICUS") of SQL Server 2005, ensure that the latest SQL Server updates are installed, and configure this new instance as instructed. In Step D, your Amicus database will be restored to the new instance.

If upgrading from Amicus Attorney 7 with the PCLaw, QuickBooks, or Timeslips Link configured to automatically handle Amicus Server restarts

After upgrading to Premium Edition, the Log On settings for the new Amicus PE Service will need to be configured as detailed in the "Configuring your system to handle Server restarts" section of the appropriate Link Guide.
